

Independent Quality Assurance Agency Survey: 2010

Every independent school in South Africa is required to be accredited by IQAA (Independent Quality Assurance Agency) which is a body appointed by ISASA (Independent Schools Association of Southern Africa).

This is part of the process to ensure that all schools are compliant according to specific government regulations.

In response to these requirements, Kearsney hosted or carried out the following in 2010:

- IQAA survey completed by boys, staff and parents.
- IQAA Internal Evaluation conducted by Internal Evaluation team.
- Site visit from IQAA-appointed mentor.

The survey and focus groups involve the boys, staff and parent body.

The internal evaluation involves class visits in which members of the internal evaluation team visit other teachers' classes, as well as focus groups to discuss the results of the survey mentioned above.

RESULTS:

The results for **Kearsney** are shown and compared with **national averages** for all other independent secondary schools (co-ed, girls only, boys only, boarding and day schools).

The percentage return from our parents was excellent at over 60%.
