Category 1: *Wildlife*

A **single image** featuring live animals in their natural habitat, including mammals, reptiles, amphibians, fish, insects, birds, molluscs and arthropods. The environment can add greatly to the quality of your image (just think about a leopard in a tree, or an insect on a flower). Try not to photograph a pet!

Category 2: *Objects in space*

A wide-open category focussing on an object or person set in a landscape (natural or man-made). Remember the rule of thirds and ensure the eye is drawn to the subject in the landscape. Lighting is all-important. This can be in colour or black and white.

Category 3: *People portrait* (black and white)

Capture the essence of a person in a single photograph. Focus on beautiful lighting, a clean background and get your focal point (usually the eye) just right. This must be in black and white.

Category 4: *A moment to remember*

Capture a moment, place, experience or person and preserve it for history. Think about the next generation taking your image out of a time capsule and visualising this moment from the past through your image.

Category 5: *Fashion*

A **single image** that focusses on displaying clothing or accessories. The image is usually a portrait of a person wearing the clothing, but it can be a part of the person if that is more effective (hands for jewellery, feet for shoes, the eyes for makeup).

Category 6: *Architecture*

An image of a building, inside or out, that portrays the beauty or uniqueness of that building. This can be in colour or black and white.

Category 7: *Dusk to dawn*

A wide-open category, the focus here is on capturing mood in difficult lighting conditions.

COMPETITION RULES

- The competition is open to any pupil in high school.
- There are no limitations on the camera equipment you can use - use what you have, as long as it is capable of producing an image of at least 1mb in size. (If images are smaller a motivation needs to be submitted with the image).
- Only images submitted by the due date will be considered.
- All images to be uploaded using the Culture@Kearsney upload facility (refer to instructions on the next page). Please ensure images are named using the following naming convention:
 - Category number_Image name
 - E.g. 1_Flowers at sunset, 3_Siblings
- All entries must be original photographs taken between the period 1 August 2020 – 21 May 2021. No archived images will be accepted.
- The competition board reserves the right to query any image submitted.
- The images remain the copyright of the photographer. The competition reserves the right to publish the images in order to promote or market the competition and winners' results.
- The photographers reserve the right to use the submitted images for their own personal use but not to enter the image into any other photographic competition within 6 months of the closing date of this competition.
- Competitor's entry fee is R100. This fee entitles the entrant to submit **5 images in each category**. 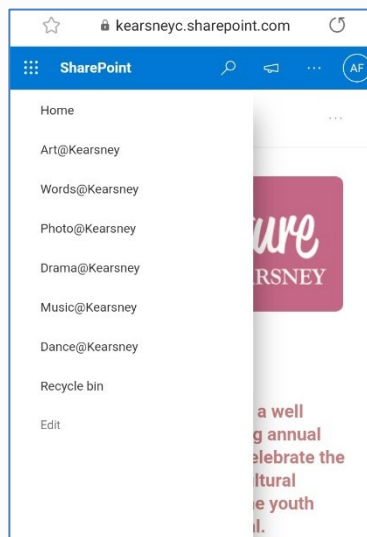

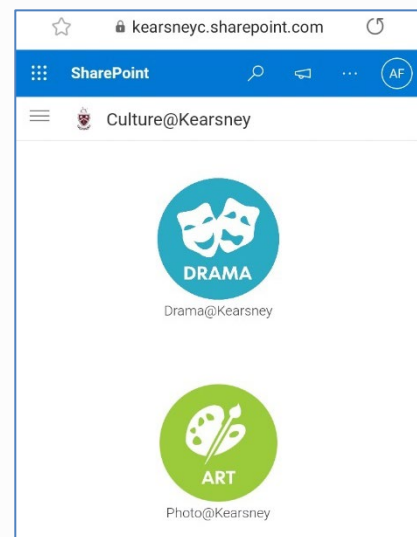
Home page



Menu options



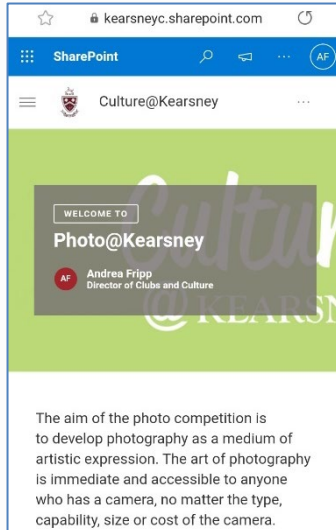

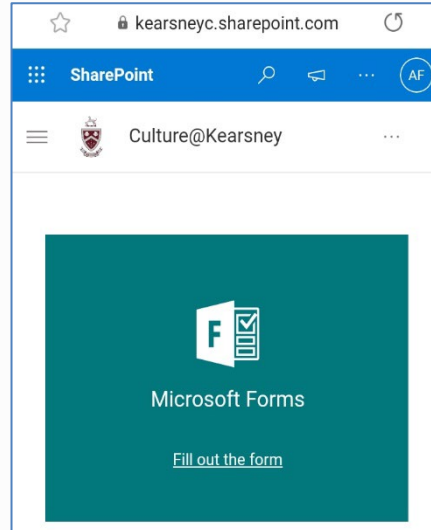
