Category 1: *Wildlife*

A single image featuring live birds and animals in their natural habitat (no pets please!). This category is divided into two sections.

1A Winged life

1B Feet on the ground

The setting can add greatly to the impact of the image, so keep this in mind.

Category 2: *Art of space*

This broad category allows the photographer to captivate the audience with an object or person set in an interesting landscape, either natural or man-made.

Remember the rule of thirds and ensure the eye is drawn to the subject in the landscape. Lighting is all-important.

Category 3: *My inspiration*

Your image should evoke inspiration and hope.

Focus on beautiful lighting, a clean background and get your focal point (usually the eye) just right.

Category 4: *Architecture*

An image of a building, inside or out, that portrays the beauty, or uniqueness of that building.

Category 5: *Dusk to dawn*

Capture mood in challenging lighting conditions.
