Key Responsibilities:

Additional Information:

- the intern programme is a fixed-term one-year contract. Candidates must re-apply annually;
- accommodation is provided on our beautiful campus, within close reach of the city of Durban from the start of Term 1 to the end of Term 4;
- male interns are required to live in single accommodation the boarding houses;
- three meals per day and laundry service are provided during the term;
- you will receive an annual allowance to assist with your study fees and be eligible for paid study leave;
- you will have access to on-campus gym facilities.
