Grade 08 to 12 debit orders and additional extras

Accounts must be paid by a compulsory eleven-month debit order. In addition to the annual charges, certain pupils avail themselves of other facilities such as school transport, music tuition, gym membership, extra academic tuition, etc. The school fees and most incidentals are invoiced over eleven months and the debit orders are linked to the actual amount owing on the statement each month from January to November. The debit order run will commence either on 15 January or the last working day in January. Any outstanding amount after the end of November will be cleared with a final debit order run in December. No allowance is made for absence from school for illness, extended holiday, financial and disciplinary reasons. In certain circumstances, on application, payments may be made termly in advance, provided that all arrears are settled in full before the commencement of the first term, and that payment will be made by no later than the first day of the month preceding the start of the term.

Grade 12 fees

All matric candidates are required to pay the IEB Examination Fee of **R 9 164** which will be invoiced over nine months from January. The College reserves the right not to enter pupils whose accounts are not fully paid up by the latest examination entry date. From 2025, Grade 12s may elect to pay their school fees over 10 months from January to October. **From 2030, it will be compulsory for Grade 12 fees to be payable over 10 months.**

Upfront payment of fees

A 5.5%, 4.5% and 3.5% discount is offered if the annual fees are settled in full before 29/11/2024, 31/12/2024 and 31/01/2025 respectively. The discount is applied to tuition and boarding and net of any scholarship, bursary or other discount. The upfront payment discount is not offered to parents who are on financial assistance.

Payment

For security reasons, cash will not be accepted. If the upfront payment option is elected payment must be made by the abovementioned dates to secure the discount. Payments must be made to the Kearsney College Trust and paid directly into our banking account: **Standard Bank, Hillcrest Branch, Acc No. 052 019 365, Branch Code 045726, Swift Code: SBZAJJ**. Where money is either transferred electronically or deposited directly into the College's bank account, a copy of the payment confirmation must be emailed to the Debtors Controller, Miss Kerry Kidwell on kkidwell@kearsney.com.

Bank charges

Bank charges incurred on credit/debit card and online platforms will be billed to your account. Returned debit orders will incur a charge. Bank charges incurred on foreign exchange and cash deposits will be billed to your account.

Special discounts for two or more brothers at the College at the same time

Two brothers – 5.0% discount on the annual fee of each of the brothers. Three or more brothers – 10.0% discount on the annual fee of each. The discount is applied to tuition and boarding net of any scholarship, bursary or other discount.

Non-SA resident deposit

For pupils from outside South Africa, the College requires that three months' fees be held by the College as a refundable deposit. This is in addition to the Acceptance Fee payable and is separate to any repatriation fees that may be required by the Government. This deposit must be paid before the pupil enters Kearsney College and will be refunded when the pupil leaves the College.

Technology fee

Over the next three years (2025-2027) a laptop roll-out is planned for the College. The technology fee is required to contribute to the costs of the advancement of technology in the College, including the infrastructure, resources and equipment. After three years, every pupil in the school will have access to a laptop for the duration of their school career. **The fee will only be payable by the pupil, once their grade receives a laptop.** This may be different for each grade. Transport fees

Daily and weekly transport is available for day scholars and boarders at a monthly fee. Viable routes are subject to pupil numbers. Airport transfers within the scheduled pick-ups are not charged. Transport for boarders to medical and specialist medical appointments within the Hillcrest area is not charged. Any medical or airport transport required outside of these parameters will be charged at a rate as determined by the Transport Manager, Mr Wiseman Ngwane on transport@kearsney.com.
